

RS 200 Winter Championships - Bristol Corinthian Yacht Club

3rd and 4th February 2018

Event Specific Sailing Instructions

- 2.1.1 The official notice board is situated in the main entrance to the club house on the right hand side wall as you enter.
- 4.1.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flag halyards on the balcony in front of the club house.
- 5.2.1 Six Races are scheduled, three each day. The first warning signal will be at 11.55 on the first day and at 10.55 on the second day.
- 7.1.1 The permitted race area is anywhere on the Cheddar Reservoir.
- 13.2 Shortened Course
For courses that are shortened when the committee boat is in its normal position and displaying flag S (alongside the class flag if more than one fleet is on the course), the leading boat shall round the leeward mark on its required side and proceed to the normal finish line. On completing the same number of rounds as the leading boat, all other boats should proceed to the finish line in the same way. When the leeward mark is a gate, boats are not required to pass through the gate but must leave the mark nearest the Committee Boat on the required side before proceeding to the finish.
This changes RRS 32.2.
- 13.3 At any other mark of the course the race may be shortened in accordance with RRS 32.2. All competitors shall complete the number of rounds equal to the leading boat before proceeding to the finish.
