NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)

1. Racing Rules

1.1. Racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the RYA, the relevant rules of the RS 200 Class Association and, this NOR except where any such rules are changed by the Sailing Instructions

2. Entries

- **2.1.** Entry will be on the day in the clubhouse between 09:00 hrs and 10:00 hrs
- **2.2.** Only boats paying the entry fee and completing an Entry Form may compete
- **2.3.** An entry fee of £20.00 will be made
- **2.4.** An efficient buoyancy aid will be worn by all competitors when afloat.

3. Notices to competitors

- **3.1.** Sailing Instructions will be available on the day and posted on the club web site. www.wwsc.org.uk 30 days prior to the event.
- **3.2.** Notices to competitors (including changes to the Sailing Instructions) will be posted on the Regatta notice board (A window of the Race Control hut).and competitors informed at a pre-race briefing.
- **3.3.** A briefing will be held at 10:15 hrs by the Race Hut.

4. Schedule of races

- **4.1.** Five races are planned, two 45 to 60minute (maximum) races back to back in the morning and three 30 to 40 minute races back to back after lunch.
- **4.2.** If five races are sailed four will count. If fewer than five races are sailed all races will count
- **4.3.** The start time for the first race will be 11:00 hrs. Other start times may be varied and extra briefings called at the Race Officer's discretion.
- 4.4. No Warning Signal will be given after 16:00 hrs

5. Insurance

5.1Each participating boat must be insured, and must declare so, with a valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000.
